BACKGROUND:

Scope of Work

The Financial Management Consultant will provide support to the PMU/Finance department of the GoUK, to ensure that there are adequate financial management systems in place both at various AdministrativeDepartment, Directorates and units and (where relevant). The Consultant will guide the implementation of the Financial reforms, whilst working closely with and building the capacity of the FD department.

As such, a Financial Management Advisor is required to assist in the process of Financial Management as well as to consolidate the capacity of the Finance and other relevant staff by mentoring and working alongside them.

- Ensure proper management and disbursement of funds following a sound accounting, budgeting, financial control and audit procedures acceptable to the Government of Uttrakhand.
- Preparing monthly, quarterly and annual financial reports as MIS for the FD for Expenditure Control, Revenue Generation etc.
- Develop system database to track funding and expenditure of various Administrative Departments
- Undertake study of various Revenue Generation Department in relation to revenue generation, leakages in revenue system, recommendation for enhancement of revenue generation.
- Undertake study of major Departments as recommended by FD for Business process Reengineering.
- Evaluation of Commitment based accounting in Government Departments to determine the commitments of on -going Projects.
